When you appear before the Community Advocate Panel, you must bring this completed form outlining the cost of your actions. Use the form below to calculate the cost of damages your actions have brought upon the community, your family and yourself. If you need help, please ask your parents or another adult for assistance.

You must figure both the direct costs of your actions as well as the indirect costs. A definition of each follows:

Direct Cost: A direct cost involves the immediate damages your actions have caused to the victim and those involved with the incident. Examples- the cost of the item shoplifted, the police time, the time the victim lost from work.

Indirect Cost: An indirect cost involves the results of your actions upon you, your family, the community and any other costs that arise over time that are related to the incident.
