On-Site Counseling Services:

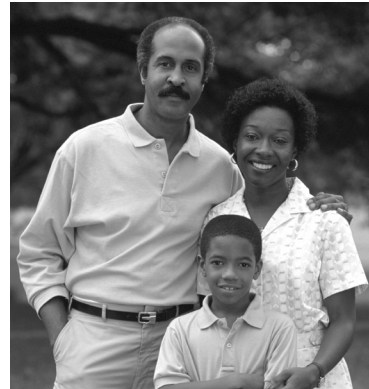
Counselors are available on-site to speak with youth and parents.
