This camp will enhance your child's knowledge of safety, while they have fun! Many area businesses, community agencies and service clubs have joined with the Forest Lake Police to be a part of this exciting program.

At camp, children will have the opportunity to experience and learn about a variety of safety issues, such as first aid from trained Emergency Medical Services personnel, bike maintenance, trail safety and laws relating to bike riding, fire safety, and electrical safety. Other issues relating to safe streets and personal safety will also be addressed. Children will have a chance to view safety equipment and vehicles. Lunch will be provided each day. Campers should bring their own bikes on Wednesday, June 17<sup>th</sup>.

The program cost includes a free bike helmet and T-shirt, leadership, supplies, snacks, and camp certification. The actual cost per child is well over \$100. Due to the generous support of our sponsors, we are able to offer this camp to you for \$25/child.

Scholarships will be available to children based on the free lunch program.

Dear Parent or Guardian,

We are looking forward to spending two days with your child during the 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Forest Lake Safety Camp. In order to provide the best care and safety to your child, we would like to review a few details with you to ensure a smooth and fun camp experience for your child.

Please bring your child into the building for registration on both days of the camp. This ensures that all children are monitored and properly routed to their groups. We will have a sign-in / sign-out process to increase the safety of your child. You will be given a numbered I.D. band for your child to wear both days. Whoever picks-up your child at the end of each day MUST show that ID number to a Safety Camp volunteer in order for your child to be released from our supervision.

Don't forget to <u>bring your child's bike on Wednesday</u>, June 17th. Please **mark your child's name** in some fashion, which is easy to identify, on his or her bicycle. Many children have the same or very similar bikes. Marking your child's equipment will ensure that no one is confused about who owns which bike.

The Forest Lake Lions Club generously donates lunch for the campers and volunteers each day. On Tuesday, they are planning to serve hamburgers and french fries and on Wednesday they will serve hot dogs and chips. If your child has a food sensitivity or you would prefer to send a different meal, please clearly mark your child's lunch. We cannot guarantee refrigeration, so be prepared to send food that will not spoil. There will be a collection box at the registration table each day for lunch boxes. Additionally, please notify us at registration if your child has a separate lunch.

Many of our activities are located outside. Historically, these days get hot and sunny. Please **send a water bottle each day for your child with their name clearly marked.** We will provide a "hydration station" for the children and remind them to drink plenty of water throughout the day.

Please remember to **apply sunscreen** to your child before camp. They will be outside for many hours each day. Additionally, please **do not send them in flip-flops or open-toe shoes**. You might wish to send a hat or sunglasses to protect them from the sun. Again, clearly mark their items and check the lost-and-found each day if an item has disappeared.

We invite parents to join the children for lunch at 12pm and afternoon programming on Wednesday, June 17<sup>th</sup>. Also, **Camper Graduation** is a very special time for each child to be recognized and acknowledged at the end of Safety Camp. This time has become very significant to each camper as their name is called and they

receive a t-shirt and certificate of graduation. Graduation will begin <u>around</u> 3:30 pm. **Please plan to attend graduation and stay for the entire program to join us in recognizing the participation of every child.** If you do not want to miss graduation, we suggest that you arrive by 3:15pm.

We would like to stress the importance of the **Drop-Off and Pick-Up Policy**. Please drop off your child <u>no earlier than</u> 8:30 A.M. each morning. Your child will be done with camp <u>no later than</u> 4:00 P.M. each day. This means that you should arrange a ride for your child by 4:00 P.M. each day, no exceptions! If you cannot personally get your child at the end of each day, please check in at the Registration Desk each morning to notify a Safety Camp official about who will be picking-up your child. We desire to respect the time and commitment of our volunteers by allowing them to clean up and leave each day by 4:00 P.M. Thank you for your cooperation.

Again, we look forward to a very fun and exciting Safety Camp. Thank you for allowing us the privilege of improving the safety and knowledge of your child.
